Our 2018 Burnside Road Dry Creek Valley Zinfandel offers intense aromas of jammy blackberry and plum. The mouthfeel is rich and vibrant with an array of pronounced dark fruit flavors laced with cinnamon, subtle vanilla and lively black pepper.



A delightful finish of cherry, cocoa powder and nutty tannins lingers alongside a perfectly-balanced, fresh acidity.

We recommend pairing with hearty dishes such as grilled eggplant, braised short ribs or beef tenderloin.
